CALL FOR NOMINATIONS 2010 WOOD ENGINEERING LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Wood Engineering Division of the Forest Products Society is proud to announce this call for nominations for the 2010 Wood Engineering Achievement Award. This award recognizes excellence in the discipline of wood engineering, including structures, structural elements, building codes, consensus standards, design procedures and education. It is intended to honor achievements and innovations. The award alternates each year between Lifetime Achievement, Young Engineer, and Engineering Innovation awards.

This year the award is designated for the Lifetime Achievement Award. The Lifetime Achievement Award honors an individual for their cumulative contributions to the discipline of wood engineering. Significant and measurable impact must be demonstrated and tangible evidence of accomplishment in the marketplace is key.

AWARD ADMINISTRATION

The Wood Engineering Achievement Award Committee of the Wood Engineering Division will evaluate nominations. The committee consists of three FPS members representing academia, industry, and government, each serving a 3-year term.

The award is sponsored by the AF&PA American Wood Council and consists of an engraved plaque and an honorarium. It will be presented at the Forest Products Society 64th International Convention, June 20-22, 2010, Monona Terrace Community & Convention Center, Madison, Wisconsin.
